RE: What a Difference a Few Days Makes!

Wow...it's amazing how quickly things can change in a mere 13 days. The last update that I sent out on August 6th included an aerial photo of SMRR that was taken on August 3rd. In that photo you can clearly see that nearly 3/4ths of the Mid-Section of the lake had been completed and that construction on the Western area had not even been started.

On Saturday, August 16th I arrived on site expecting to see that some good progress had been made on the lake. To say that I was impressed with what had been accomplished since I had been out earlier in the week would be an understatement. As luck would have it, I was able to capture the last few big loads of dirt being excavated from the very western most end of the lake near what will be the SMRR main entry! In the picture below you can see that the island has been formed and the scraper is hauling off a full load of dirt. To orient you, this picture was taken from Lot 18 looking NW across the lake to Lot 20 and Lot 1.



To dig almost two entire ski runs in 13 days is simply amazing progress and is easily an LSF Dev. Corp. record! Stay tuned for more details and updates as construction continues. I'll be in touch soon!
